Categories are how vocabulary gets organised in the head. A child who knows that a carrot is a vegetable, a food and a thing that grows can find the word three ways, and can learn a new vegetable in one go. Category work has three directions: given the members, name the group; given the group, name members; given a set with one stranger in it, find the stranger and say why. The last one is the hardest, because it needs the rule the others share.

What to expect: Young children sort by what things look like or where they are found ("the spoon goes with the bowl") before they sort by kind. That is not wrong, and "why do those go together?" is the question that moves it along. A child who can sort but cannot name the group ("these are all... um") has the concept and needs the word; a child who names one member when asked for the group ("what are these? - a cow") needs the idea that a word can stand for a set.
